This N.C.O. gathered together remnants of his Company and reorganised, when all the Coy. Officers had become casualties. After the allotment of all available men to their tasks he personally, under heavy enemy shell-fire and sniping, came back to En. Hdqrs. and supplied most urgent information on the situation. 	-do-	5291.	Pte. Adolf Sven ADOLFSON.	For conspicuous gallantry in attack on DAISY WOOD on 9/10/17. When the advance had been temporarily held up, this man who was then in charge of a Lewis Gun rushed forward and engaged two enemy posts with success. His No. 2 on the gun became a casualty so Adolfson alone established a post 40 yards ahead of the advance. Here his timely action was responsible for the repulse of a local enemy counter-attack. 	-do-	744.	Pte. Arthur Clarence NEALE.	For conspicuous gallantry in advance on BROODSEINE RIDGE on 4/10/17. This runner went forward with the Advance Command Post party and fearlessly carried messages under heavy shell-fire a distance of 700 yards to the C.O. In a later run en route between Coys. he met another wounded runner, took the important message and personally at great personal risk through heavy enemy fire succeeded in delivering it.
